Article 1 - Definitions

- 1. Website (hereinafter "Website"). Lighthouse Bookings Engine used for Hotel the Match BV, legal business name Hotel the Match BV.
- 2. Controller of personal data (hereinafter "Controller"): Lighthouse/Stardekk, located at Rijselstraat 2A 8200 Brugge Belgie.

Article 2 - Responsibilities

- 1. The controller is not liable for breakdowns, interruptions or problems in the functioning of the website, as a result of which the website or any of its functionalities are (temporarily) inaccessible. You yourself are responsible for the way in which you connect to our website. You are responsible for taking all appropriate measures to protect your equipment and data against dangers such as virus attacks on the Internet. Furthermore, you are solely responsible for which websites you visit and what information you search for.
- 2. The Administrator shall not be liable for any legal action taken against you
- for using the website or services accessible via the Internet
- For violating the terms of this privacy policy
- 3. The Administrator shall not be liable for any damages incurred by you or third parties or your equipment, as a result of your connection to or use of the Website and you shall refrain from any subsequent (legal) action against the Administrator.
- 4. If the controller is involved in a dispute because of your misuse/use of this website, it shall be entitled to (re)claim all resulting damages from you.



Article 3 - Collection of data

- 1. Your personal data is collected by Lighthouse and (an) external processor(s).
- 2. Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject").
- 3. An identifiable natural person is a person who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identification such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identification or to one or more factors characterising the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.
- 4. The personal data collected on the website are used by the data controller mainly for maintaining a (commercial) relationship with you and, if applicable, for processing your orders. They will be included in an (electronic) register.

Article 4 - Your rights with regard to information

1. Under Article 13(2)(b) GDPR, every data subject has the right to information about and access to, and rectification, erasure and restriction of the processing of their personal data, as well as the right to object to processing and the right to data portability.

Article 5 - Retention of data

The data collected will be used and kept for the duration determined by law.

Article 6 - Applicable law

These terms and conditions are governed by Dutch law. The court in the district where the data controller is established has exclusive jurisdiction to hear disputes about these terms and conditions, unless a statutory exception applies.
